INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A GRAVITY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO.1 OF THE PARISH OF POINTE COUPEE

Parish Administrator John Grezaffi presented and reviewed an introduction of a proposed ordinance to create a Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Pointe Coupee in the Morganza Floodway.

Motion by Mr. A. Dukes and seconded by Mr. Pourciau:

NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE AND OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Parish Code of Ordinances be amended for an ordinance to create a Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Pointe Coupee, fixing the boundaries thereof, appointing five (5) commissioners therefor, designating the domicile and providing for the organization thereof and other matters in connection therewith has been introduced before the Police Jury of the Parish of Pointe Coupee, Louisiana, and that a public hearing will be held relative thereto at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 8, 2015 at the Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Annex, 160 East Main Street, New Roads, Louisiana, after which said ordinance may be considered for adoption. CONSIDERATION OF 2016 MEDICARE RENEWAL FOR RETIREES

Insurance Agent Claude Jarreau presented the renewal of the Humana Medicare Advantage Employer Plan for group health insurance for retirees age 65 and over, effective January 1, 2016.

Motion by Mr. Cline and seconded by Mrs. Vosburg:

RESOLVED, That the renewal of the Humana Medicare Advantage Employer Plan for group health insurance for retirees be accepted.

UPDATE ON PC RECREATION FOOTBALL FIELD

Juror Cox introduced and placed Mr. Delaney Lee, representing PC Rec Football Team, on the agenda to obtain an update from the Jury on the status of the football fields and the lighting, and asked the Recreation Committee to establish a notification process when events are cancelled.

Mr. Lee voiced concerns and complaints from parents about not having an adequate practice field and lighting for the football team at False River Recreation Park. Juror Vosburg stated that Mr. Lee and the parents are always informed and invited to attend the Recreation Committee meetings to address any concerns about recreation. She apologized for the delay, and reported the lights should be installed between November and December. She thanked Mr. Brian Pangburn for his contributions to the Recreation Program.

Mr. Lee requested portable lights for the football team to use for practice. Juror Cox offered his assistance with providing the portable lights.

Juror Cox suggested that the Recreation Committee develop a notification process when teams are not allowed to practice on certain fields and practices have been cancelled.

INTRODUCTION OF 2015 BUDGET AMENDMENTS AND 2016 BUDGET OF THE POLICE JURY

Treasurer Becky Mayeux presented amendments to the 2015 operating budget and gave an introduction of the 2016 operating budget of the Police Jury. She reported the budget was introduced to the Finance Committee on October 26, 2015 and the committee has scheduled another meeting on November 19, 2015 to review and accept any changes to the budget before the public hearing in December.

Motion by Mr. Cox and seconded by Mr. A. Dukes:

RESOLVED, That upon introduction of the amendments to the 2015 operating budget and the 2016 operating budget of the Police Jury, that a public hearing be scheduled for Tuesday, December 8, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. to review and consider adoption of the budget.

Unanimously carried.

DISCUSSION & CONSIDERATION OF INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR EVENTS AT THE MULTI-USE CENTER

Multi-Use Center Director Weldon Jewell discussed the additional insurance coverage for events at the center. The cost for additional event insurance, general liability insurance, is between \$200 and \$500, which would be on a case by case basis.

Motion by Mr. C. Dukes and seconded by Mrs. Vosburg:

RESOLVED, That Assistant District Attorney John Wayne Jewell be authorized to craft a policy for event insurance for various events at the Multi-Use Center, and the Parish Administrator be authorized to prepare a fee schedule of the cost for the amounts of coverage for event insurance.

Unanimously carried.

DISCUSSION OF CHRISTMAS PARTY

Treasurer Mayeux discussed the budget of \$1,200 paid by Jurors to fund the Christmas Party for employees. Due to limited funds, the Jury discussed purchasing hams for each employee, instead of hosting a party.

Motion by Mrs. Vosburg and seconded by Mr. C. Dukes:

RESOLVED, That the \$1,200 allocated by Jurors to host a Christmas Party be used to purchase hams for each employee for Christmas.

Unanimously carried.

Juror Cox asked Treasurer Mayeux to obtain an opinion from CPA Tommy LeJeune about whether Jurors can fund the purchase of hams for employees.

APPROVAL TO HAVE AN ORDINANCE CRAFTED FOR ZONING ALONG LA HIGHWAY 415 AT VENTRESS

Juror C. Dukes requested approval to craft an ordinance for zoning along LA Highway 415 at Ventress, due to the operation of an auto mechanic shop in a residential area.

Motion by Mr. C. Dukes and seconded by Mr. A. Dukes:

RESOLVED, That Attorney Dannie Garrett be authorized and tasked to craft an ordinance for zoning along LA Highway 415 at Ventress.

CONSIDERATION OF CONDEMNATION OF AN ABANDONED HOUSE ON LOT 36 IN JV LOUPE SUBDIVISION OWNED BY VIRIGINIA HARGROVE

Juror A. Dukes requested approval to proceed with the condemnation of an abandoned house in J. V. Loupe Subdivision that has not been repaired, after a public hearing was held in August and a 90-day extension was granted to the property owners to repair the house.

RESOLVED further, That Mrs. Melanie L. Bueche be authorized to execute the above plats for Gloria Brown, Rhonda D. Knowles, LLC and Raymond Garrett, and a sideline variance for Stuart & Chasity Olinde.
