MINUTES POINTE COUPEE PARISH COUNCIL June 14, 2022

June 14, 2022

The Pointe Coupee Parish Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. Tuesday June 14, 2022, at the Courthouse Annex in the Parish Council Meeting Room, New Roads, Louisiana.

Chairman Boudreaux called the meeting to order and directed Council Clerk Gerrie Martin to call the roll:

APPROVE MINUTES OF MAY 10, 2022 & JUNE 1, 2022 MEETING

Motion by Mr. Bazile and seconded by Mr. LaCoste:

RESOLVED, That the minutes of May 10, 2022 regular meeting and June 1, 2022 special meeting of the Parish Council be adopted as presented and published in the official journal.

Unanimously carried.

SPECIAL BUSINESS:

PRESENTATION OF RETIREMENT AWARD TO JEROME DUHE

Parish President Major Thibaut announced the presentation of a retirement award to employee Jerome Duhe for 16 years of dedicated service.

4-H PROGRAM RECOGNITION

4-H Agent Sara Rodrigue gave an overview of the 4-H program in the parish. She recognized the grand champion exhibitors in livestock, (Grant Carriere, Ryder Morales and Andi Speights) and shooting sports (Evans Magruder, Madden Pourciau, Abigail Hawkins, Naythan Holmes and Matthew Lorio), who introduced themselves. In closing, she thanked the council for the opportunity to attend the meeting and their continued support of the 4-H program.

Parish President Major Thibaut and Chairman Boudreaux congratulated the students for their accomplishments.

PRESENTATION OF 2021 ANNUAL AUDIT REPORT SUBMITTED BY KOLDER, SLAVEN & COMPANY, LLC

CPA Rob Carter of Kolder, Slaven & Company, LLC presented and gave a summary of the 2021 annual audit report for the parish. He reported there were no findings in the report.

Motion by Mr. Bergeron and seconded by Mr. Bazile:

RESOLVED, That the 2021 annual audit report submitted by Kolder, Slaven & Company, LLC for the Pointe Coupee Parish Government be accepted.

PARISH PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Parish President Major Thibaut presented the financial report of the monthly budget to actual

comparison on the ad valorem property taxes, sales tax collections, gas collections, licenses & permits, state severance, and state & federal funds, that included total revenues received of \$7,678,426 and total expenditures of \$4.252,142 for the month of May. He applauded Finance Director Tonilyn Guidry and Assistant Finance Director Becky Mayeux for no findings in the audit report and a great job in managing the finances.

Chairman Boudreaux commended the success of the parish and their finances, and thanked all who played a role in the success.

PUBLIC COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS

There were no public comments.

DISCUSSION OF A PROPOSED ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE POINTE COUPEE PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CREATING AND REESTABLISHING A SINGLE BOARD TO SERVE AS THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY FOR EACH OF THE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS IN EXISTENCE AND IN THE FUTURE CREATED IN POINTE COUPEE PARISH, IN ACCORDANCE WITH LRS 40:1504, AND THEREAFTER, CONSIDERATION OF THE ADOPTION

Town of Livonia Mayor Rhett Pourciau commented on his objections to the proposed ordinance creating and reestablishing a single board to serve as the governing authority for each of the fire protection districts. He reported that he spoke with the other three mayors in the parish and they are against reestablishing a single board.

Chairman Boudreaux reported on Attorney Henry Olinde assisting the study committee organized to review the ordinance and matters pertaining to reestablishing a single board for the fire districts. He reported Attorney Olinde was unable to attend the meeting to review the additional amendments he made to the ordinance. Chairman Boudreaux asked that this matter be deferred until a later date.

Motion by Mr. Bergeron and seconded by Mr. Soulier:

RESOLVED, That the Parish Council defer actions until a later date on the proposed ordinance creating and reestablishing a single board to serve as the governing authority for each of the fire protection districts in existence and in the future created in Pointe Coupee Parish, in accordance with LRS 40:1504.

Unanimously carried.

DISCUSSION OF A PROPOSED ORDINANCE TO ENACT SECTION 17-60 OF THE POINTE COUPEE PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES, RELATIVE TO THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER IN THE PARISH, AND THEREAFTER, CONSIDERATION OF THE ADOPTION

Attorney Dannie Garrett gave an overview of amendments made to the proposed ordinance to enact Section 17-60 of the Pointe Coupee Parish Code of Ordinances, relative to the Telecommunications tower in the parish. He also commented on meetings with representatives from SBA Communications & AT&T Mobility regarding their concerns and suggested amendments to the ordinance. After discussion, the following resolution was offered:

A hearing to obtain public input to a proposed ordinance to amend Section 22-19 of Chapter 22 of the Pointe Coupee Parish Code of Ordinances, relative to subdivisions and building setback lines for residential lots fronting False River, and otherwise provide with respect thereto was conducted at 6:06 p.m., Tuesday, June 14, 2022 at the Parish Council Meeting Room, Courthouse Annex, 160 East Main Street, New Roads, Louisiana.

President Thibaut gave a summary and reason for the amendments to the building setback lines for residential lots fronting False River.

Resident Gregory Johnson voiced concerns about the plan, relative to District A.

Chief Demographer Mike Hefner of Geographic Planning & Demographic Services, LLC gave a summary of the reapportionment plan and proposed ordinance. He reported due to the 2020 census, there was a decrease in population in District A, and explained the increase of the minority population to 53%.
