Parish President Major Thibaut gave updates and PowerPoint presentation on the following: Various grants received; bid opening for security system at the detention center; water sector grants & consolidation of PC Parish Waterworks District No. 1 with False River Waterworks; Upper Delta Soil & Water Conservation District Drainage Project; drainage work being performed throughout the parish; animal shelter is at capacity; opening bids 2/1/23 for the Richey Street Drainage Project; proposed projects being considered for HMGP funding; Pecan Island Bridge Replacement Project; basketball program at PC Rec have 20 teams with games being played at Catholic High gym, events held at PC Multi-Use Center and future events scheduled, improvements at PC Rec, multi-use center and Batchelor Recreation Park; HVAC system at the detention center, renovations to the Courthouse Annex Building will begin in February; advertising for sale of surplus equipment; reduction in complaints about solid waste and bulky waste
