The Pointe Coupee Parish Council Executive Committee met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 23, 2023, at the Courthouse Annex in the Parish Council Meeting Room, New Roads, Louisiana.

APPROVE MINUTES OF APRIL 25, 2023 MEETING

PUBLIC COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS

DISCUSSION ABOUT THE STATISTICS OF FEMA'S FLOOD RISK 2.0

Parish Administrator Mark Ward presented written information and gave an overview of the FEMA's flood Risk Rating 2.0 that became effective in June of 2022. He reported on data FEMA is using to calculate the flood risk that is mainly affecting the coastal parishes in the state, and little affect on Pointe Coupee.

Parish President Major Thibaut commented on the Attorney General wanting to dispute the 2.0 flood risk, and asking parishes to join in the lawsuit against FEMA.

DISCUSSION & RECOMMENDATION FROM PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 17 AND CHAPTER 22 OF THE PC PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES

Planning & Zoning Commission Chairman Jim Beard gave an overview of meetings with CPEX and the commission regarding amendments being considered by the commission to the code of ordinances for planning & zoning in the parish. He reported on an amendment to Chapter 17 of the code of ordinances to include permitting for commercial, seasonal outdoor for a special use permit request to establish fireworks stand at Oscar. He reported on proposed amendments being made to the Subdivision Ordinance in Chapter 22 of the code of ordinances.

Chairman Boudreaux reported one of the ordinances being introduced at the special meeting today will provide for the change to the ordinance and thereafter, approve special use permit for the fireworks stand.
