## Pointe Coupee Parish Building Permit Requirements

- 1. Proof of ownership of property.
- 2. Obtain an official 911 address for property you elect to build on by calling the 911 addressing office at 225-638-9556.
- 3. Obtain a Sewer Permit from the Parish Sanitation Dept. 225-638-3373.
- 4. Submit one (1) complete set of construction plans to the permit. Construction plans shall consist of the following:
  - a. Elevation View of the Front, Side, and Rear of the building.
  - b. Roof Plan
  - c. Floor Plan
  - d. Electrical Plan
  - e. Foundation Plan
  - f. Plumbing Plan
  - g. HVAC Plan
  - h. Structure Details
- 5. Plot plan showing size and location of lot and building location on lot from lot lines.
- 6. Plan specifications must list owner name, building address, square footage, window and door openings schedule, general materials of construction, and roof pitch.
- 7. Res-check, Building thermal Envelope-compliance Certification, Energy Code.
- 8. Building is to be located on property to suit the following property setback lines. Front and rear setback from property line 25 foot. Side setback is 8 feet from property line.
- 9. All properties will require a current land survey in the name of the owner.
- 10. All buildings constructed above ground on pier and beam method may be required to adhere to local wind speed zone calculations.
- 11. Any building constructed with a ridge beam at or exceeding the height of 30 feet may be required to adhere to local wind speed zone calculations.
- 12. Any building constructed with a roof pitch greater than 12 on 12 may be required to adhere to local wind speed zone calculation.
- 13. Any building constructed on pier and beam method; a foundation plan will be required to show the method of attachment from ground foundation thru floor joist members.
- 14. Permits will only be issued to qualified licensed contractors or building owners who submit names and license numbers of the owners qualified subcontractors.
- 15. All commercial permits must be pulled by license commercial contractors.
- 16. Qualified licensed contractors are to register in the parish with the Parish Government office on an annual basis.
- 17. And any other requirements as provided by parish ordinance or building code.
